



New Crescent Moon of Ramadan 1441:

The Astronomical New Moon (conjunction) is on April 23, 2020 (Thursday) at 2:26 UT. On that day, the moon may be seen in Central America and in some Polynesian Islands with difficulty. On April 24, the moon can be seen in almost the whole world easily (See visibility curves).


